ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 12, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Albert J. Scipione, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

A telephonic prehearing conference was held on May 14, 2015, attended by counsel for the Division of Enforcement (Division). Neither Respondent, who is currently incarcerated, nor any representative attended the prehearing conference on his behalf. Counsel for the Division indicated that Respondent had not been responsive throughout this administrative proceeding and the related civil proceeding that preceded it. Based on materials filed by the Division, I find that Respondent was personally served with the OIP by April 29, 2015,¹ and that his Answer is due by May 19, 2015. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b).
