ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings on February 21, 2014, pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. On September 5, 2014, I issued an initial decision. *Gary L. McDuff*, Initial Decision Release No. 663, 2014 SEC LEXIS 3207. On April 23, 2015, the Commission vacated the initial decision and remanded this proceeding for further development of the record. *See Gary L. McDuff*, Exchange Act Release No. 74803, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1657. On April 30, 2015, I ordered supplemental briefing by the parties to be submitted by June 10, 2015. *Gary L. McDuff*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2613, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1646.

On June 8, 2015, the Division of Enforcement sent this Office a motion seeking an extension of time to file its supplemental briefing. The Division represents that due to health issues affecting Division counsel and her immediate family, counsel has been unable to adequately prepare briefing in response to my April 30 order. The Division requests a two week extension to June 24, 2015. The Division has been unable to contact McDuff to determine whether he opposes the motion, however, to avoid any prejudice, the Division requests that the extension also apply to him.

Accordingly, for good cause shown under 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(b), I GRANT the Division's Motion. To prevent any prejudice to McDuff, both he and the Division shall have until June 24, 2015, to submit the supplemental briefing described in my April 30 order.
