POST-HEARING SCHEDULING ORDER

THRASOS TOMMY PETROU

On October 27, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and-Desist Proceedings (OIP) against Respondent Thrasos Tommy Petrou (Petrou), pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (Advisers Act). The hearing took place on June 8, 2015, in New York City.

During the hearing I ordered a portion of the hearing transcript to be sealed, having found the harm resulting from disclosure of the information to outweigh the benefits of public disclosure. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.322(b). Therefore, the sealed portion of the transcript will be available only to Petrou, Petrou's counsel, and employees of the Commission.

I ORDER that the following post-hearing schedule be followed:

- 1. The parties shall file a joint exhibit list by July 1, 2015. The parties shall also submit a Microsoft Word version of their joint exhibit list to this Office at ALJ@sec.gov, by July 1, 2015, which specifies the exhibit number; description of the exhibit; Bates-stamp numbers, if any; and page(s) in the hearing transcript in which the exhibit was offered and admitted.
- 2. The parties are responsible for filing their respective exhibits in hardcopy format, as well as any motion for a protective order, with the Office of the Secretary by July 1, 2015. The parties shall also submit electronic copies of any exhibits not already filed to this Office by June 12, 2015.
- 3. The Division of Enforcement and Petrou shall file simultaneous post-hearing briefs, no longer than fifteen pages, by July 10, 2015. No reply briefs will be filed.
