POSTPONEMENT ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings on May 19, 2015, pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and 9(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940, and the hearing was scheduled to commence on June 22, 2015. The Division of Enforcement (Division), with the consent of Respondent Richard Krill, has requested that the hearing be postponed and a telephonic prehearing conference scheduled on June 15, 2015.

Accordingly, consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the hearing will be postponed *sine die*, and a prehearing conference will be held by telephone on Monday, June 15, 2015, at 11:00 a.m. EDT.
