ORDER POSTPONING
HEARING

On May 26, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondents pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A hearing is scheduled to commence on June 19, 2015.

On June 8, 2015, a Declaration of Service was filed stating that a process server served the OIP and other documents on Aux (USA), Inc., by leaving a copy of the papers with the Delaware Secretary of State on June 1, 2015. I find that Aux was served in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), on June 1, 2015. *See* 8 Del. C. § 321(b). Aux's Answer was due by June 11, 2015. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b).

On June 10, 2015, the Division of Enforcement filed a Declaration of Service showing that Respondents ANTH1, Inc., Asat Holdings Ltd., Asia Quest Ventures, Inc., and Barton Solar Acquisition, Inc., were served with the OIP by June 2, 2015, by mailing the OIP by Priority Mail Express to Respondents' most recent addresses shown on each entity's most recent filing with the Commission.¹ *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). I find that ANTH1, Asat, Asia Quest, and Barton were served with the OIP by June 2, 2015, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), (iv), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv).² ANTH1, Asat, Asia Quest, and

Barton's Answers are due by June 15, 2015. The Declaration does not address whether Ares Global Assets, Inc., has been served.

To allow time for service on Ares and Answers from all six Respondents, the June 19, 2015, hearing is POSTPONED *sine die*. A prehearing conference will be scheduled after the Division files a declaration of service as to Ares.
