ORDER POSTPONING HEARING,
SCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE, AND TO SHOW CAUSE

On June 16, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, July 7, 2015.

On June 19, 2015, the Division of Enforcement filed a Declaration of Service, asserting that Respondents were served with the OIP by June 17, 2015, by mailing the OIP by Priority Mail Express to Respondents' most recent addresses shown on each entity's most recent filing with the Commission. I find that Respondents were served with the OIP by June 17, 2015, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). As such, Respondents' Answers were due by June 30, 2015. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). As of today, none of the Respondents have filed an Answer.

Accordingly, I ORDER that on or before Monday, July 13, 2015, Respondents shall SHOW CAUSE why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failure to file Answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondents fail to respond to this Order, they will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against them, and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).

Furthermore, I ORDER that the hearing currently scheduled for July 7, 2015, be POSTPONED, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 2:00 p.m. EDT on July 13, 2015.
