ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

I ORDER that the hearing scheduled to begin on July 20, 2015, is POSTPONED *sine die* and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 10:00 a.m. EDT on August 24, 2015, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
