ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Respondent's Answer to the OIP was due by July 14, 2015. *See Vantone Int'l Group, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2922, 2015 SEC LEXIS 2825 (July 9, 2015). Respondent has not filed an Answer to date.

It is ORDERED that Respondent shall SHOW CAUSE by July 28, 2015, why this proceeding should not be determined against it due to its failure to file an Answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondent fails to respond to this Order, it shall be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 2-3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
