ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SERVE RESPONDENT BY ALTERNATIVE MEANS

On July 14, 2015, the Division of Enforcement filed a motion to serve Respondent Gedrey Thompson by alternative means. Specifically, the Division wishes to serve Thompson by: (1) publication in The Daily Gleaner and The Daily Observer, two newspapers in Jamaica, West Indies, Thompson's last known location, and (2) by email at Thompson's last known email address.

For the reasons stated in the Division's motion, brief in support, and accompanying declaration of its counsel, such service is permitted by Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(iv), and the Division's motion is GRANTED. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(iv). The Division may serve Respondent in the manner listed above. As proposed by the Division, publication in the listed newspapers shall occur once per week for four consecutive weeks. The Division shall promptly notify the Commission's Office of the Secretary and this Office on completion of its proposed method of service.
