ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On June 30, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings.

Respondents' Answers to the OIP were due by July 27, 2015. *See Green Planet Solutions Corp.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2943, 2015 SEC LEXIS 2956 (July 20, 2015). As of today, no Respondent has filed an Answer.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that Respondents shall SHOW CAUSE by August 7, 2015, why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failure to file Answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. If a Respondent fails to respond to this Order, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
