## ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On August 12, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings.

On August 17, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration of service establishing that Respondents Com-Animation, Inc. (a/k/a Com-Animatrix, Inc.), and TPI Enterprises, Inc., were served with the OIP by U.S. Postal Service priority mail express on August 14, in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii).<sup>1</sup> As such, their Answers are due August 27. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

I POSTPONE the hearing currently scheduled for August 28 and schedule a telephonic prehearing conference for 11:00 a.m. EDT on September 8. If Com-Animation and TPI Enterprises fail to timely file Answers, appear at the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding, they will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against them, and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
