ORDER EXTENDING  
STAY

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and-Desist Proceedings in this matter on March 30, 2015. On June 10, 2015, I stayed this matter pursuant to a request by the U.S. Attorney for the Eastern District of New York. *Aegis Capital, LLC*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2794, 2015 SEC LEXIS 2328. I also ordered that a telephonic prehearing conference would take place on September 10, 2015, but would be canceled if the U.S. Attorney filed a written notice asking that the stay remain in effect and providing reasons for the stay to remain in effect. *Id.*

On September 4, 2015, the U.S. Attorney filed a periodic status report providing reasons why the stay should remain in effect. Accordingly, I GRANT the U.S. Attorney's request, and ORDER that the stay remains in effect. A telephonic prehearing conference in this matter will take place on Friday, January 8, 2016, at 11:30 a.m. EST. If the U.S. Attorney files a written notice before that date, asking that the stay remain in effect and providing reasons for the stay to remain in effect, the telephonic prehearing conference will be canceled.
