The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on July 16, 2014, pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. *Toney Anaya*, Securities Act Release No. 9613, 2014 SEC LEXIS 2568 (July 16, 2014). The OIP, pursuant to Toney Anaya's offer of settlement, made various findings of fact and conclusions of law, imposed a cease-and-desist order and other sanctions on him, and ordered additional proceedings to determine what, if any, civil penalties against him are in the public interest. *Id.* The Commission stated that these issues may be determined on the basis of affidavits, declarations, excerpts of sworn deposition or investigative testimony, and documentary evidence. *Id.* at \*12.

Procedural questions and the dates for the parties' filings will be addressed at a telephonic prehearing conference to be held on Tuesday, September 15, 2015, at 2:00 p.m. EDT, a date and time convenient to the parties.
