PREHEARING ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), on August 12, 2015. The OIP alleges that each Respondent is a corporation with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act and has repeatedly failed to file required periodic reports. Only Modern City Entertainment, Inc. (Modern City), remains in the proceeding. A prehearing conference was held today. Neil J. Welch, Jr., Esq., appeared for the Division of Enforcement (Division), and William Erfurth, Modern City's President, appeared for Modern City. Modern City's accountant, Brad Hacker, was also present.

The Division was granted leave to file a motion for summary disposition pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.250, which will be due by October 14, 2015. Modern City may file an opposition by November 10, 2015, and the Division, a reply, by November 17, 2015. Modern City may file a motion for summary disposition according to the same schedule.
