CI4NET.COM INC., CURRAGH, INC., AND REPHEX, INC. ORDER POSTPONING HEARING, SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE, AND TO SHOW CAUSE

On August 25, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondents, pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The OIP alleges that Respondents each have a class of securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled for September 23, 2015.

The Division of Enforcement has filed a declaration establishing that Respondents were served with the OIP by September 2, 2015, in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv). Respondents' Answers were due by September 15, 2015. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). As of today, no Respondent has filed an Answer.

It is ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for September 23, 2015, is POSTPONED, and a prehearing conference is scheduled for October 8, 2015, at 11:00 a.m. EDT, if the proceeding has not been resolved before then. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Respondents shall SHOW CAUSE by September 28, 2015, why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failure to file Answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. See 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f). If Respondents fail to respond this Order, they will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against them, and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
