ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND TO SHOW CAUSE

On September 15, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings against Respondents pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

A telephonic prehearing conference was held today, attended only by counsel for the Division of Enforcement. In addition to failing to appear at the conference, Respondents have failed to file Answers, due by October 9, 2015. *See AgriBioTech Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3175, 2015 SEC LEXIS 3991 (Sept. 30, 2015).

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that on or before October 23, 2015, Respondents shall SHOW CAUSE why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failures to file Answers, attend the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend this proceeding. If a Respondent fails to respond to this Order, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
