ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On August 10, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings (OIP) against Respondent pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

On September 28, 2015, the Division of Enforcement filed an affidavit of service, establishing that Respondent was served with the OIP by hand delivery on September 22, 2015. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(i). Respondent's Answer was therefore due on October 12, 2015. See OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). As of today, Respondent has not filed an Answer.

Accordingly, Respondent is ORDERED to SHOW CAUSE by October 26, 2015, why this proceeding shall not be determined against him due to his failure to file an Answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondent fails to respond to this Order, he shall be deemed in default and the proceeding will be determined against him. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).
