ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On October 16, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings.¹

Respondent New Leaf Brands, Inc., was served with the OIP on October 20, 2015, and its Answer was due by November 2, 2015. *Life Care Med. Devices, Ltd.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3260, 2015 SEC LEXIS 4394 (Oct. 26, 2015). As of today, New Leaf has not filed an Answer.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that New Leaf shall SHOW CAUSE by November 13, 2015, why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an Answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If New Leaf fails to respond to this Order, it shall be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
