NICHOLAS ROWE	ORDER ON DOCUMENT SUBPOENAS

On November 13, 2015, Nicholas Rowe requested the issuance of document subpoenas to twelve individuals. In part, those subpoenas request documents relating to non-disclosure agreements, settlements, and communications with attorneys.

To the extent, if any, that a recipient of one of these subpoenas determines that a requested document should be excused from production based on privilege, the purportedly privileged document should not be produced at present. If only a portion of the document is privileged, a copy with the privileged information redacted should be produced. In lieu of the production of a document, or portion thereof, for each document, the individual asserting the privilege should identify the particular privilege(s) asserted, the author of the document, all recipients, a general description of the nature of the document (e.g., email, report) and the subject it relates to, and the date of the document.

Rowe shall include a copy of this Order with each subpoena he serves on the twelve individuals.
