The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted proceedings in this matter on March 30, 2015. On June 10, 2015, I stayed this matter pursuant to a request by the U.S. Attorney for the Eastern District of New York. *Aegis Capital, LLC*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2794, 2015 SEC LEXIS 2328. I extended that stay on September 8, and ordered that a telephonic prehearing conference would take place on January 8, 2016, but would be canceled if the U.S. Attorney filed a written notice that requested and provided reasons for the stay to remain in effect. *Aegis Capital, LLC*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3103, 2015 SEC LEXIS 3654.

On January 6, 2016, the U.S. Attorney submitted a status report requesting and providing reasons for the stay to remain in effect. Accordingly, I POSTPONE the scheduled prehearing conference and ORDER the stay to remain in effect. A telephonic prehearing conference in this matter will take place on Monday, May 16, 2016, at 10:30 a.m. EDT. If the U.S. Attorney files a written notice before that date asking and providing reasons for the stay to remain in effect, the telephonic prehearing conference will be canceled.
