STAY ORDER

On February 22, 2016, the Division of Enforcement submitted a motion to stay this proceeding. The Division represents that the parties have agreed in principle to a settlement of this proceeding on all major terms and that it has mailed to Respondent a proposed settlement offer. The Division further represents that although a joint motion was not filed by the parties due to Respondent's incarcerated status, both parties request the stay and Respondent consents to its motion.

I construe the motion as a joint motion to stay within the meaning of Rule of Practice 161(c)(2). The motion is GRANTED and this proceeding is STAYED, subject to compliance with that rule, requiring that this office be notified promptly if any of the requirements of the rule are not met. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2).

In light of the stay, the hearing scheduled for March 7, 2016, is CANCELED.
