DEVEN SELLERS and ROLAND BARRERA	

This proceeding commenced with the issuance of an order instituting proceedings against Respondents Deven Sellers and Roland Barrera on December 15, 2015. Pursuant to the briefing schedule proposed by the parties and adopted by me on January 28, 2016, the Division of Enforcement filed a motion for summary disposition on February 29, and Respondents' oppositions are due today, March 15. *Deven Sellers*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3547, 2016 SEC LEXIS 299. After my office received two emails this morning from Barrera appearing to request an extension of one or both of these deadlines, I issued an order earlier today explaining that any such request must be made in writing and filed in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice. *See Deven Sellers*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3706.

My office received this afternoon a motion from Barrera asking that he be given seven days, or until March 22, 2016, to file a motion for summary disposition. The motion does not request an extension of time to file his opposition to the Division's motion. Barrera apparently asserts that he was unable to prepare his motion for summary disposition in time to meet the deadlines set in my January 28 order because of delays he encountered when attempting to obtain the transcript for the prehearing conference held on February 4, 2016.

It is ORDERED that the Division shall file a statement by March 17, 2016, indicating whether it objects to Barrera's motion for an extension of time. An electronic courtesy copy of the Division's statement should be sent to this office and Respondents.
