ORDER GRANTING
EXTENSION

After finding Edward M. Daspin in default, I ordered the Division of Enforcement to file a motion for sanctions by April 6, 2016, allowed Daspin to file an opposition by April 27, and the Division a reply by May 9. *Edward M. Daspin*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3713, 2016 SEC LEXIS 1000, at *6 (ALJ Mar. 16, 2016). Today, the Division submitted a letter requesting that its reply due date be extended by three days to May 12. The Division represents that it did not receive Daspin’s opposition, which is voluminous, until May 2—three business days after it was due. The Division also notes that Daspin consents to the requested extension.

For good cause shown, the request for extension is GRANTED. The due date for the Division’s reply is extended to May 12, 2016.
