The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings on November 9, 2015, pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A fourth prehearing conference was held today. Martin F. Healey, Esq., appeared on behalf of the Division of Enforcement, and Respondent Sandip Shah, who is incarcerated at FCI Sheridan in Oregon, appeared *pro se*.

A hearing had been scheduled to commence on May 17, 2016, but cannot be held on that date due to a number of logistical difficulties. However, the parties have been engaging in settlement negotiations. Also, the Division will explore modifying its request for sanctions. The May 17 hearing will be postponed *sine die*, and the Division will file a status report by May 18.
