ORDER SCHEDULING PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting administrative proceedings on November 22, 2013, alleging that Respondent Joseph P. Doxey violated registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Division of Enforcement filed a motion for summary disposition, and on May 15, 2014, I issued an initial decision granting the Division's motion and imposing sanctions. *Joseph P. Doxey*, Initial Decision Release No. 598, 2014 SEC LEXIS 1668. On May 5, 2016, the Commission determined that disputed issues of material fact exist and remanded the case. *Joseph P. Doxey*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10077, 2016 SEC LEXIS 1665.
