On April 29, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. Respondents were served with the OIP by May 5, and their answers are due May 18, 2016. *Coyote Res., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3836, 2016 SEC LEXIS 1707 (ALJ May 12, 2016). To date, Respondents have not filed answers.

Accordingly, Respondents are ORDERED to SHOW CAUSE by no later than May 31, 2016, why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failures to file answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. Any Respondent that fails to respond to this order will be deemed in default and the registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).
