ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION
FOR PREHEARING SCHEDULE

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings on March 29, 2016. At a prehearing conference on May 9, 2016, the parties agreed to a start date of September 12, 2016, for the hearing. *Christopher M. Gibson*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3834, 2016 SEC LEXIS 1682, at *2 (ALJ May 10, 2016). I then ordered the parties to file a proposed schedule setting out prehearing procedural deadlines. *Id.*

The parties filed a joint motion for entry of a prehearing schedule on May 23, 2016. The motion is GRANTED, and I adopt the parties' proposed schedule as follows:

- July 8, 2016: The Division provides Respondent with its witness and exhibit lists, and copies of pre-marked exhibits.
- July 15, 2016: The Division provides Respondent with its expert report(s).
- July 22, 2016: Respondent provides the Division with his witness and exhibit lists, and copies of pre-marked exhibits.
- July 29, 2016: Respondent identifies any objections to the Division's exhibits.
- August 5, 2016: Respondent provides the Division with his expert report(s).
- August 12, 2016: The Division identifies any objections to Respondent's exhibits.
- August 19, 2016: The Division provides Respondent with its rebuttal expert report(s).
- August 26, 2016: Prehearing briefs are filed.
- September 12, 2016: The hearing begins in Washington, D.C., at Commission Headquarters.

Only the prehearing briefs are to be filed with the Office of the Secretary.
