ORDER POSTPONING HEARING, SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND TO SHOW CAUSE

On May 24, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled for June 21, 2016.

On May 31, 2016, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration of service establishing that Respondents were served with the OIP by May 27, 2016, in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). Respondents' answers were therefore due by June 9, 2016. See OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). To date, Respondents have not filed answers.

Accordingly, I ORDER that on or before June 20, 2016, Respondents shall SHOW CAUSE why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failures to file answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondents fail to respond to this order, they will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against them, and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).

I FURTHER ORDER that the hearing currently scheduled for June 21, 2016, is POSTPONED, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 3:00 p.m. EDT on July 5, 2016, if the proceeding is not resolved before then.
