ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Accordingly, Respondents are ORDERED to SHOW CAUSE by no later than July 25, 2016, why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failures to file answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. Any Respondent that fails to respond to this order will be deemed in default and the registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
