ORDER POSTPONING HEARING

On June 27, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondent has securities registered with the Commission and is delinquent in its periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled to commence on July 25, 2016.

The Division of Enforcement emailed my office and advised that it has no reliable means of contacting or serving the OIP on Respondent, located in China, other than by serving Respondent through the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents, a process that in China can take many months.

Accordingly, I ORDER that the July 25, 2016, hearing is POSTPONED. I FURTHER ORDER the Division to file by July 29, 2016, a declaration memorializing the representations the Division made in its email to my office, with accompanying evidence, if any. On October 28, 2016, the Division should file a declaration providing an update on the status of service, and should provide subsequent updates every three months thereafter.
