ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On August 10, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is currently scheduled for August 29, 2016.

On August 18, 2016, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration of service establishing that Respondents were served with the OIP in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii) by August 15, 2016. Respondents' answers to the OIP are therefore due by August 29, 2016. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(a)-(b), .220(b). If Respondents fail to timely file answers or otherwise defend the proceeding, they will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against them, and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).

I ORDER that the August 29, 2016, hearing is POSTPONED, and that a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held on October 11, 2016, at 2:00 p.m. Eastern, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
