ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On August 10, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. Respondents were served with the OIP by August 15, 2016, and their answers were due by August 29, 2016. *Ameralink, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 4093, 2016 SEC LEXIS 2998 (ALJ Aug. 25, 2016). To date, no respondent has filed an answer.

Accordingly, I ORDER Respondents to SHOW CAUSE by September 19, 2016, why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failures to file answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. Any Respondent that fails to respond to this order will be deemed in default and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
