ORDER SCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On June 8, 2015, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia entered an order in *Hill v. SEC*, No. 1:15-cv-1801, preliminarily enjoining the Securities and Exchange Commission from proceeding in this matter, prompting the Chief Administrative Law Judge to cancel the upcoming hearing. *Charles L. Hill, Jr.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2789, 2015 SEC LEXIS 2288 (ALJ June 9, 2015). Following a ruling by the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit, the district court dismissed *Hill v. SEC* on September 14, 2016. ECF No. 51.

On September 16, 2016, the Division of Enforcement filed a notice of the district court's dismissal and requested that I schedule a prehearing conference. The parties have represented that they are available for a telephonic prehearing conference at 2:00 p.m. EDT on September 27, 2016. Accordingly, I ORDER that a telephonic prehearing conference will occur on September 27, 2016, at 2:00 p.m. EDT. Before the conference, the parties should confer and propose a hearing date.
