ORDER SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On November 17, 2015, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia entered an order in *Ironridge Global IV, Ltd. v. SEC*, No. 1:15-cv-2512, preliminarily enjoining the Securities and Exchange Commission from proceeding in this matter and prompting me to cancel the schedule then in place. *See Ironridge Glob. Partners, LLC*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3329, 2015 SEC LEXIS 4759 (ALJ Nov. 17, 2015). On September 28, 2016, the district court approved plaintiff's notice of voluntary dismissal without prejudice pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(i), thus vacating the injunction.<sup>1</sup> *See Ironridge v. SEC*, Docket, ECF No. 32.

The parties have notified my office that they are available for a prehearing conference on October 18 or 19, 2016. Accordingly, I ORDER that a telephonic prehearing conference will occur on October 19, 2016, at 2:00 p.m. EDT. Before the conference, the parties should confer and propose a prehearing and hearing schedule.
