ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE,
POSTPONING HEARING, AND
SCHEDULING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On November 17, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondents under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and failed to file required and periodic reports. A hearing is scheduled for December 19, 2016.

On December 2, 2016, the Commission issued an order making findings and revoking the registration of Harvey Westbury Corp.'s securities, and this proceeding is concluded as to that Respondent. *Harvey Westbury Corp.*, Exchange Act Release No. 79452, 2016 SEC LEXIS 4463.

Also on December 2, 2016, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration of service establishing that Kalex Corp. and InterCore, Inc., were served with the OIP in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii) by November 22, 2016. These Respondents' answers were therefore due by December 5, 2016. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). To date, these Respondents have not filed answers.

I ORDER that the hearing is POSTPONED, and that a telephonic prehearing conference is scheduled for December 16, 2016, at 10:30 a.m. Eastern.

I ORDER Kalex Corp. and InterCore, Inc., to SHOW CAUSE by December 16, 2016, why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failures to file answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. If these Respondents fail to respond to this order or fail to appear at the upcoming prehearing conference, they will be deemed in default and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(1)-(2), .220(f), .221(f).
