ORDER RESCHEDULING
HEARING

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an order instituting proceedings (OIP) on January 25, 2017, under Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933. A hearing is scheduled for February 21, 2017.

On January 30, 2017, the Division of Enforcement submitted a declaration of service establishing that a process server served Respondent through its registered agent on January 30, 2017, in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii) and 15 U.S.C. § 77h(d). Respondent's answer is, accordingly, due February 9, 2017. *See* OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). Section 8(d) of the Securities Act requires that a hearing occur within fifteen days of service of the OIP, which in this case is by February 14, 2017. *See* 15 U.S.C. § 77h(d). To ensure that the hearing is held within the required fifteen-day period, the hearing is RESCHEDULED for February 13, 2017, at 11:00 a.m. EST, at the Commission's Headquarters, Hearing Room 2, 100 F St N.E., Washington, D.C. 20549. Respondent may participate in person in Washington, D.C., or by videoconference. Respondent should notify this office how it intends to proceed by emailing alj@sec.gov or calling (202) 551-6030 by no later than February 9, 2017.
