SCHEDULING ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on December 20, 2016, pursuant to Sections 203(e), 203(f), and 203(k) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and Section 9(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940. The OIP alleges that Respondents violated and/or willfully aided and abetted and caused violations of the antifraud provisions of the Advisers Act. The hearing, expected to last five days, has been set to commence on October 16, 2017, in Chicago, Illinois, consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.200(c). This order addresses the parties' January 25, 2017, Proposed Scheduling Order.

As proposed by the parties, the following prehearing schedule is adopted:

August 4, 2017: Parties to exchange and file witness and exhibit lists.

August 11, 2017: Parties to file written expert reports they intend to offer in lieu of direct testimony and to exchange with each other copies of marked exhibits (in written form and electronically).

September 18, 2017: Parties to file rebuttal expert reports.

October 2, 2017: Parties to file prehearing briefs, any motions *in limine*, exhibit lists, stipulations as to facts and admissibility of documents, and objections to exhibits or witnesses.

October 10, 2017: Telephonic prehearing conference at 10:30 a.m. EDT.
