POST-HEARING ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding under Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933 on January 25, 2017. On February 10, 2017, after Respondent failed to answer the Order Instituting Proceedings, I ordered Respondent to show cause and warned that if Respondent failed to attend the hearing scheduled for February 13, 2017, or otherwise defend the proceeding, it may be found in default. *Infeed Medica Corp.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 4597, 2017 SEC LEXIS 435. At the February 13 hearing, the Division of Enforcement appeared but Respondent did not.

Also on February 10, 2017, the Division submitted a motion for default against Respondent supported by several exhibits, including emails of Asher Zwebner, the alleged undisclosed promoter and control person of Respondent, among other documents. *See* Div. Exs. E-S. At the hearing, I explained that to rely on these exhibits, the Division will at least need to file a declaration attesting to what each exhibit represents and explaining how it was obtained. I ORDERED the Division to provide such a declaration by February 23, 2017.
