The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on February 7, 2017, pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and the hearing was scheduled to commence on March 6, 2017. The proceeding is a follow-on proceeding based on *United States v. Herman*, No. 1:12-cr-10015, ECF Nos. 299-300 (D. Mass. Aug. 1, 2016), *aff'd*, __ F.3d __, No. 16-2001, 2017 WL 474341 (1st Cir. Feb. 6, 2017), in which Respondent Rosalind Herman was convicted of securities and wire fraud and other crimes.¹

The Division of Enforcement has requested that the hearing be postponed and a prehearing conference scheduled; the Division has conferred with Respondent's unit manager concerning an appropriate time and date for the prehearing conference. As the Division requests, and consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the hearing will be postponed *sine die*, and a prehearing conference will be held by telephone on Thursday, March 9, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. EST.
