The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on February 7, 2017, pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. The proceeding is a follow-on proceeding based on *United States v. Herman*, No. 1:12-cr-10015, ECF Nos. 299-300 (D. Mass. Aug. 1, 2016), *aff'd*, 848 F.3d 55, (1st Cir. 2017), in which Respondent Rosalind Herman was convicted of securities and wire fraud and other crimes. A prehearing conference, at which the Division of Enforcement and Respondent Rosalind Herman appeared, was held today.

Respondent Herman explained that her previous counsel has withdrawn and family members are searching for new counsel. Accordingly, and consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the date for her Answer to the OIP was set at March 30, 2017. The Division of Enforcement will make its investigative file available to her or to new counsel. A second prehearing conference will be held by telephone on Thursday, April 27, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. EDT.
