POST-HEARING ORDER

The Division of Enforcement appeared at today's hearing, but Respondents did not. Respondents also have not filed their answers or otherwise defended this proceeding. Therefore, I ORDER Respondents to SHOW CAUSE by March 31, 2017, why this proceeding should not be determined on default. 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(1)-(2), .220(f), .310.

In addition, I ORDER the Division to file its exhibits and exhibit list with the Office of the Secretary by March 24, 2017, providing a Word version of the exhibit list to my office via e-mail to alj@sec.gov. At the hearing, the Division requested that it be permitted to file its exhibits in electronic format. Although the Rules of Practice are silent on this issue, given the voluminous nature of the Division's exhibits, I GRANT the request. I direct the Division to maintain and preserve genuine copies of any electronic exhibits in the event it is requested to resubmit them in any appeal from the undersigned's initial decision.

By April 14, 2017, the Division must file its post-hearing brief. The Division may file one consolidated brief or three briefs (one regarding each Respondent), but the cumulative number of pages should not exceed thirty.
