ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND
SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On April 5, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent John T. Lynch, Jr. The OIP ordered a hearing to determine whether it is appropriate in the public interest to bar Lynch from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, municipal securities dealer, municipal advisor, transfer agent, or nationally recognized statistical rating organization. This hearing is scheduled for May 11, 2017.

On April 13, 2017, the parties submitted a joint motion to adjourn the hearing and schedule a prehearing conference. This motion is GRANTED. The hearing scheduled for May 11, 2017, is POSTPONED, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held on May 1, 2017, at 2:00 p.m. Eastern.
