STAY ORDER

On April 27, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A hearing is scheduled for May 26, 2017. On May 16, 2017, the parties jointly requested a stay and the Division of Enforcement provided my office with a copy of Respondent's signed and notarized offer of settlement. The hearing is CANCELED, and this proceeding is STAYED pending the Commission's consideration of the settlement offer, subject to compliance with Rule of Practice 161(c)(2), 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2), requiring the parties to promptly notify this office if any of the requirements of the rule are not met.
