The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, on May 9, 2017, and the hearing was scheduled to commence on June 5, 2017. The OIP alleges that each Respondent is a corporation with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act and has repeatedly failed to file required periodic reports. The proceeding has ended as to Ciralight Glob., Inc. *Ciralight Global, Inc.*, Exchange Act Release No. 80778, 2017 SEC LEXIS 1569 (May 25, 2017). The Division of Enforcement is seeking to revoke the registration of the securities of the remaining Respondents, GS EnviroServices, Inc., IPOWorld, and Parabel, Inc. (collectively, Respondents).

The OIP provides that each Respondent's Answer is due within ten days of service of the OIP on it. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). Each Respondent was served with the OIP by May 13, 2017, by USPS Express Mail delivery or attempted delivery at "the most recent address shown on [its] most recent filing with the Commission." 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). To date, each Respondent has failed to file an Answer within the time provided.

Accordingly, each Respondent is ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE, by June 13, 2017, why it should not be deemed to be in default and the registration of its securities revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing is POSTPONED *sine die*, and a prehearing conference shall be held by telephone on August 18, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. EDT, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
