ORDER POSTPONING  
HEARING AND FINDING  
SERVICE AS TO TWO  
RESPONDENTS

On June 7, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled to commence on June 30, 2017.

On June 12, 2017, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration reflecting that Respondents Evolucia, Inc., and OSL Holdings, Inc., were served with the OIP in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii) on June 9, 2017. Accordingly, their answers to the OIP are due by June 22, 2017. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

I ORDER that the hearing is POSTPONED *sine die*, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 2:00 p.m. Eastern on August 11, 2017, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then. I FURTHER ORDER that the Division shall file a declaration regarding the status of service efforts as to Respondent Legend International Holdings, Inc., by June 26, 2017.
