ORDER POSTPONING **HEARING AND FINDING** SERVICE AS TO TWO **RESPONDENTS**

Accordingly, their answers to the OIP are due by June 22, 2017. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

I ORDER that the hearing is POSTPONED sine die, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 2:00 p.m. Eastern on August 11, 2017, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then. I FURTHER ORDER that the Division shall file a declaration regarding the status of service efforts as to Respondent Legend International Holdings, Inc., by June 26, 2017.
