**Order to Show Cause** 

On May 31, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondents pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings.

Respondents were served with the OIP by June 5, 2017, and their answers were due by June 19, 2017. *Cardinal Res., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 4857, 2017 SEC LEXIS 1673 (ALJ June 8, 2017). To date, no Respondent has filed an answer.
