Order Postponing Hearing

On June 15, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled to commence on July 7, 2017.

On June 19, 2017, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration of service, which establishes that Respondent T3 Holdings, Inc., was served with the OIP in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii) on June 16, 2017. The declaration states that the OIP was sent to Respondent Vortronnix Technologies, Inc., at 1077 Westheimer, Suite 1100, Houston, TX 77042. Vortronnix Technologies' "most recent address shown on [its] most recent filing with the Commission" is 10777 Westheimer, Suite 1100, Houston, TX 77042. 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). Vortronnix Technologies has not yet been served with the OIP in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii).

I order that the hearing is postponed. I will schedule a telephonic prehearing conference once the Division establishes service on Vortronnix Technologies. The Division should file a supplemental declaration by July 19, 2017.
