Order to Show Cause

On June 26, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

I previously found that Respondent was served with the OIP on July 5, 2017, and its answer was due by July 18, 2017. *Ibex Advanced Mortg. Tech., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 4917, 2017 SEC LEXIS 2095 (ALJ July 17, 2017). To date, Respondent has not answered.

On July 20, 2017, I held a telephonic prehearing conference attended by the Division of Enforcement but not Respondent.

I ORDER that by July 31, 2017, Respondent shall SHOW CAUSE why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer, attend the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondent fails to respond to this order or otherwise defend the proceeding, it will be deemed in default and the registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 2-3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f), .221(f).
