**Order Postponing Hearing and
Scheduling Prehearing
Conference**

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on July 27, 2017, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled for August 23, 2017.

On August 2, 2017, the Division of Enforcement submitted a declaration establishing that Respondents were served with the OIP by July 31, 2017, in accordance with Commission Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii). *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii).¹ Respondents' answers are due by August 14, 2017. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(a)-(b), .220(b).

¹ In its most recent filing with the Commission, Respondent Aquentium, Inc., stated that its business address was located at Canyon Lake, CA 92587, which matches the city and ZIP code information in the Division's declaration. *See* Aquentium, Inc., Current Report (Form 8-K) (Mar. 15, 2017), https://www.sec.gov/Archives/edgar/data/918997/000147793217001158/aqnm_8k.htm. But the U.S. Postal Service tracking information shows that delivery was attempted in Quail Valley, CA 92587. I have confirmed with the Postal Service's Look Up a ZIP Code online tool, *see* https://tools.usps.com/go/ZipLookupAction_input, that the Postal Service uses Quail Valley, CA, as the

I POSTPONE the hearing currently scheduled for August 23, 2017. I ORDER a telephonic prehearing conference for August 16, 2017, at 2:00 p.m. Eastern. Respondents are on notice that if they do not answer the OIP, appear at the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding, I will deem them in default, determine the proceeding against them, and revoke the registrations of their securities. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).

“default city” designation for ZIP code 92587. I take official notice of this explanation for the discrepancy. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.323.

In addition, in its most recent filing, Respondent Del Toro Silver Corp. stated that its business address ZIP code was 89710. Del Toro Silver Corp., Current Report (Form 8-K) (Apr. 4, 2017), https://www.sec.gov/Archives/edgar/data/1382462/000143774917006023/dtor20170404_8k.htm. And the body of the Division’s declaration states that the OIP was mailed to that ZIP code. But the Postal Service tracking information attached as an exhibit to the declaration shows that delivery was attempted—and ultimately completed—at 89701. I have confirmed with the Postal Service’s Look Up a ZIP Code online tool that 89701 is the only ZIP code associated with Del Toro’s street address. That ZIP code is also found on Del Toro’s penultimate Commission filing, which suggests that 89710 is a typographical error. *See* Del Toro Silver Corp., Current Report (Form 8-K) (Mar. 6, 2017), https://www.sec.gov/Archives/edgar/data/1382462/000143774917003903/dtor20170306_8k.htm. I therefore take official notice of the reason for the use of a different ZIP code in the tracking information.

Finally, the Postal Service tracking information for Respondent Sealand Natural Resources Inc. shows that it was mailed and delivered to an address in Reno, NV. As the body of the Division’s declaration recognizes, Sealand’s business address in its most recent filing with the Commission was located in Oceanside, CA. *See* Sealand Natural Resources Inc., Current Report (Form 8-K) (May 16, 2017), <https://www.sec.gov/Archives/edgar/data/1522236/000149315217005449/form8-k.htm>. However, information provided by the Office of the Secretary establishes that a second copy of the OIP was mailed to the proper address in Oceanside, CA, with the tracking number EI283503539US. I take official notice of Postal Service tracking information establishing that the second copy of the OIP was delivered on July 29, 2017.
